SRS Advogados advises audio software start-up on €400,000 investment

SRS Advogados advised Portuguese audio software start-up Sound Particles in relation to Indico Capital Partners and Red Angels' €400,000 investment in the company.



Sound Particles describes its audio software as being “like a CGI software (for example, Maya or Blender), but for sound, capable of reproducing thousands of sound sources spread over a 3D space”.

The SRS Advogados team was led by partner Paulo Bandeira (pictured).

Bandeira said: "Sound Particles is a very concrete example of how Portuguese entrepreneurs and startups are leaders in technological innovation and how good projects always achieve financing and international recognition."
