

OVERTIME WORK MORE EXPENSIVE

Overtime work exceeding 100 hours per year will be paid at a different rate. Upon the entry into force of the changes to the Labour Code, overtime work exceeding 100 yearly hours shall be paid as follows, with reference to the employee's hourly rate:

a) Increase of 50% for the first hour or fraction thereof and 75% per subsequent hour or fraction thereof, on a work day;

b) Increase of 100% for each hour or fraction thereof, f on a mandatory or additional rest day or on a public holiday.
