DOMESTIC VIOLENCE: EXEMPTION FROM PRIOR NOTICE

An employee with the status of victim of domestic violence is now exempt from complying with the prior notice due to termination of employment.

Employees whose status as victims of domestic violence has been recognized will now be exempt from serving prior notice to their employer in order to terminate their employment contract. The absence of prior notice does not entail the payment of an indemnity equal to base salary and seniority payments in lieu of notice period, or any other indemnity.
