## Amendment to the domestic service regime

A sleep-in employee becomes entitled to a night rest of at least 11 hours.

The domestic service regime underwent significant changes, including:

- The normal weekly working period applicable to any domestic service employee is reduced from 44 to 40 hours;
- Domestic service sleep-in employees are now entitled to a nightly rest period of at least 11 consecutive hours (instead of the current 8 hours)
- Any harassment carried out by the employer, other members of the household or other workers shall now be grounds for termination with cause by the domestic service employee.
